

POLISH FORCES IN SCOTLAND number over 46,000 men (9,800 of whom are in the air force).

Fighting side by side with the R.A.F., the Polish Squadrons have won for themselves the unbounded admiration of all civilized nations. The Kosciuszko Squadron alone in its participation in the defense of London and other British cities, has over 300 victories to its credit.

Of Polish sailors, the First Lord of the Admiralty Albert V. Alexander said, on May 3rd, 1941: "Britain is proud to join forces with the gallant Polish Navy, whose exploits are an inspiration to all engaged in the Battle for Freedom."

For all these, as well as for the thousands of civilian Polish refugees in Scotland, hospital facilities are urgently needed.

The Edinburgh School of Medicine has temporarily loaned what space, beds and equipment it could. But separate installation is an urgent necessity. Lt. Colonel Prof. Jurasz, world famous Polish surgeon, will be in charge, with a staff of Polish medical authorities now in Scotland.

Since planning of new buildings is out of the question, arrangements are being made to take over a country house near Edinburgh.

To convert this into a hospital, to equip and organize it to relieve the strain on overcrowded British hospital conditions, will require \$50,000.
